How is the team going at the moment?

What are we working on?

How is the team going at the moment?

What are we working on?

The Team Community proposal never made it to a plenary decision, which is just as well, as there are some changes to be made to it. Some people are very for it and others not. I think the latter group are mainly concerned that it shifts the focus onto things that detract from the more important and urgent work that needs to be done, and I would like to find out more about these people's concerns before finalising the proposal. Also, Team Governance has suggested that Team Recruitment and Onboarding become a sub-circle of this team, which has a lot of advantages. This needs to be clarified in the proposal.

There is a post coming soon trying to outline how we as a team feel like we can be of most benefit to the group moving forward.

Finally, there are people looking into options for both external mediation (if needed) and further training.

Do we need anything from another team?

No, although once the logistics of the Reeflings weekend is sorted, we will need to connect with the Coordinator to see if there is something we should prepare for a potential Saturday afternoon session.
