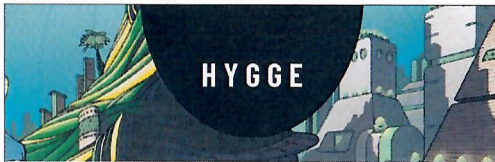

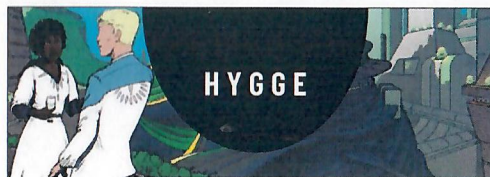
Resolution 21:

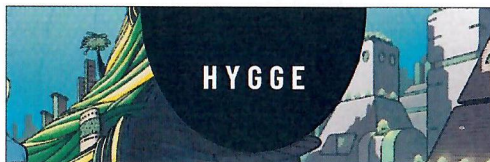
Long term thinking can be

Economy.

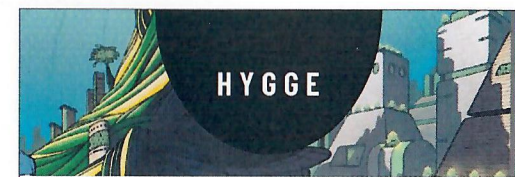
Hygge's mint can have money

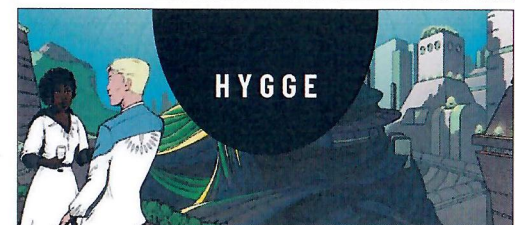

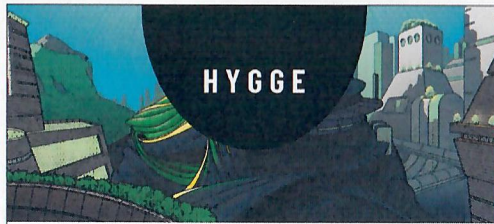

growth industries.

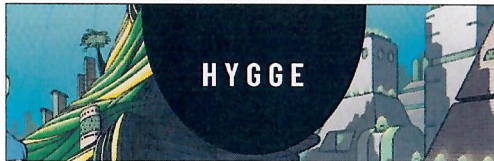

Resolution 12:

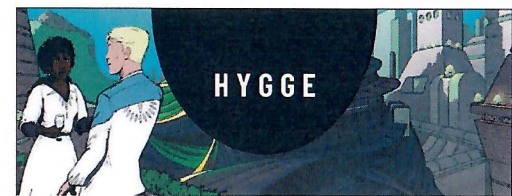
the State declares water, energy, transport, health care and education to be basic rights in Hygge, denied to no one.
